Mrs. Williamson's Update

- P.I.S.A (Programme for International Student Assessment Exam)
 - Up to 53 randomly selected 15-year-olds students
 - Measures students' literacy in math, science, reading, creative thinking and financial literacy
 - Measures how well prepared Canadian students are for learning once they leave school
 - Identifies areas for improvement by schools, education systems and governments
 - 2 testing periods of 60 minutes each and a 45 minute student questionnaire
 - Administered between April 18 and May 27, 2022
 - No results reported for individual students, schools or school divisions



Mrs. Williamson's Update

- Assurance Survey
 - Survey for all grade 10 students and their parents
 - Completed in block 3 with grade 10 students this week
 - Must be completed by April 1
- EIPS Survey
 - Survey completed by all Grade 12 students and parents for all grades
 - Will complete with Grade 12 students in block 2 next week
 - Must be completed by March 27



Mrs. Williamson's Update contd.

- Today was the exam order deadline
- We have 153 students taking 123 exams in 11 different subjects areas
 - Total cost \$10,993
- Exams take place May 2-13



Mrs. Kropp's Update



- Registration update
 - Week of March 7: Administration and counsellors completed our current Grade 10 and 11 student class selections. For the students who were away in block 1 or had a spare, their selections have been entered by our registrar, Mrs. Radke.
